Commanders: You "lead the troops" throughout the night. You handle announcements at the opening and close of the night. You provide support to the large group teachers, handbook leaders and make sure everyone stays on schedule and that rotations happen at the appropriate times.

Secretaries: You love behind the scenes work! You help welcome kids in a check-ins, provide support to small group leaders during small group, help distribute achievements as they're earned, and are an adult presence in the hallways throughout the night.

Large Group Leader: You prepare and deliver age-appropriate biblical lessons to their entire club during Large Group Time. These lessons impact the children's spiritual lives as they hear God's Word and the gospel message.

Small Group Leader: You are paired with a group of 3-5 kids that you will be with the entire night! You will help and support them as they memorize Scripture during small group time, sit with them during Large Group time, and engage with them during games/worship/fun time. You are there to disciple and build relationships with your group!

Game Leader: You plan exciting team games and encourage an atmosphere of healthy competition, good sportsmanship, and teamwork. You exhibit enthusiasm and a positive 'let's have fun" attitude!



Check in/Check Out: You love interacting with kids and are comfortable using computer software to check in and check out large groups of kids.



Name Tags: You are friendly and helpful as you assist kids in finding and putting on their name tags at check in.

Coat Room: You are comfortable helping kids stay organized as they hang up their coats and backpacks.

Snack Server: You love serving and connecting to others through food. You would love to set up tables and serve snacks & drinks.

Craft Helper: You are creative and willing to get messy with crafts. You are comfortable leading groups of kids through a craft.

Iron: You love encouraging kids to be creative and make beautiful things. You're willing to iron perler bead projects for children.

Room Supervisor: You are committed to the safety of all the Kidzone kids, but also want them to have fun! You would love to supervise and build relationships with the kids in our "Free Play" room.

Gym Games: You love sports and recreational games! You're willing to jump in with the kids to play games in the gym.

Games: You can't say no to a game of UNO or Yahtzee! You would enjoy playing board games and card games with kids.

CENTERPOINT Leader: You are passionate about leading a group of 15-25 kids closer to Jesus.

Large Group Leader: You are passionate about leading a group of 15-25 kids closer to Jesus. You are excited to engage with the lesson and activities and are willing to put in 1 hour of preparation during the week.

KIDS

Small Group Leader: You are passionate about leading a group of 5-7 kids closer to Jesus and are excited to dive into relationships with these kids. You are willing to put in 30 minutes of preparation during the week to become familiar with the activities and discussions.

Helper: You are passionate about building relationships with children and encouraging children to get the most out of their Sunday morning experience. You are comfortable in Large Group and Small Group settings and seek opportunities to support the leaders and kids.

Nursery Volunteer: You are passionate about caring for the littlest members of our congregation. You're excited to show up on Sunday morning ready to play and have fun with our babies and toddlers!

Nursery Helper: You're excited to show up on Sunday morning ready to support the nursery volunteer and play with our babies and toddlers. This is a great place for middle and high school students to serve!

6th and 7th-8th grade small group leaders (Sunday morning) — You would enjoy leading a small group discussion every other week based on discussion questions from the large group lesson. Get to know the students and help guide them towards wise Christian living.

High school group leader (Sunday morning) — You're ready to come alongside high school students as they wrestle with real-life issues that they want to address from a distinctly Christian perspective. You're willing to dive into discussion questions and Bible study provided to you each week.

Middle School youth group sponsors (Wednesday Night, Sioux Center) — You'll attend weekly Wednesday night youth group meetings, lead a small group, participate in games and activities, and attend retreats and camps with the students. Middle and High School youth group leaders (Hawarden) — You'll attend weekly Sunday night youth group meetings, lead a small group, participate in games and activities, and attend retreats and camps with the students. You invest in students relationally and mentor them in their walk with Christ.

Set up and Tear down: Behind the scenes work makes it all happen on Sunday. Come early or stay late and have your hand in all of the facility transformations that make our space into the best place to worship!

Next Steps: You welcome anyone to the next steps area and help them get connected. You are willing to guide people through our website on an iPad, interact with first time guests, and connect people with different areas of the church by using online forms.

Wednesday Night Meals: You are eager to help and connect with families from our church and the overall Sioux Center community! You enjoy working with a team to serve and clean up meals on Wednesday nights.

Midweek Deliveries: You enjoy connecting with residents living in care facilities while delivering the newsletter, worship guides and other materials.

Funeral Serving: You serve families during their time of need by helping with meal service and clean up following funerals at the Sioux Center campus.

Media team: You're comfortable with a DSLR camera and are willing to capture our services. You're able to move around the worship center, childrens ministry areas, and fellowship areas to get images or b-roll shots.
